Address Health & Safety Needs

- HVAC upgrades
- Repair parking lots and sidewalks
- Replace aging interior and exterior doors



Relieve Crowded Classrooms, Plan for the Future

- Construct 10 classrooms and additional cafeteria/multi purpose space
- Remodel existing educational wings to add classroom space and improve areas for art, drama, and music



Repair & Update Aging School Buildings

- Electrical upgrades
- Repair/replace outdated plumbing and waste systems
- Repair/replace flooring and wall finishes

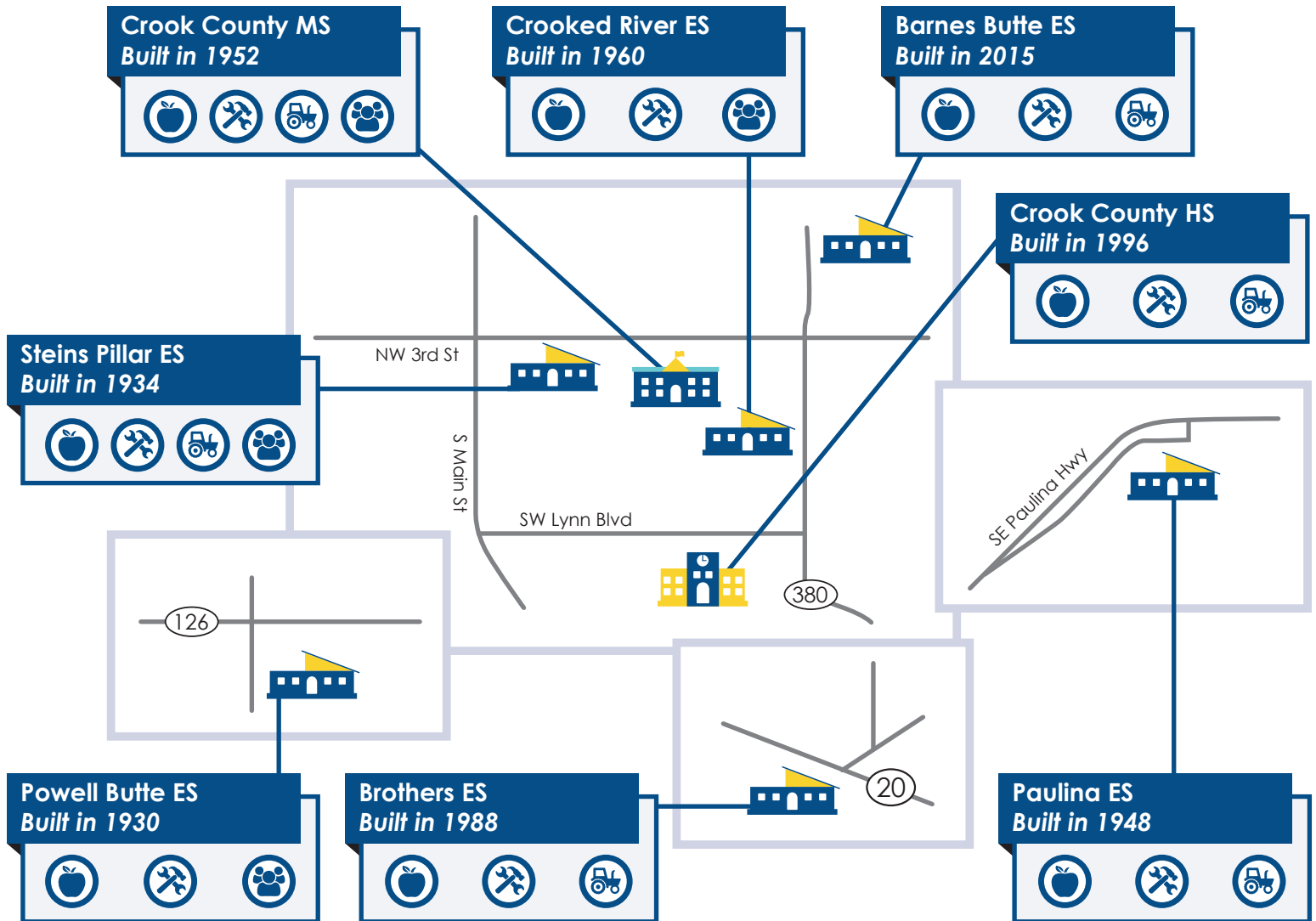

If the proposed measure passes, the school district would:

- 
Address Health, Safety & Security
 - Conduct air quality improvements
 - Install new intruder locks and security systems
 - Renovate entrances at Powell Butte Elementary for traffic safety
- 
Repair & Update Aging School Buildings
 - Upgrade HVAC, plumbing, and electrical systems
 - Install new roofs and flooring
 - Conduct ADA improvements
- 
Expand Hands On Learning & Student Opportunities
 - Expand existing CTE/Vocational classrooms
 - Update athletics and weight training facilities
 - Update performing arts spaces at CCHS
